Tropical Imports, Hammock washing instructions.

Tropical Imports looks for hammocks that are made with higher quality fabric and dye process. As a result, the colours of the hammocks should not run together when washed. Having said that, it is common for hammocks to release some left-over dye on the first washing, but that will not affect the other colours.

We recommend that all hammocks be washed by hand in cool water and detergent, although machine washing is no problem either. It is normal for some colour to remain in the water on the first wash, but the hammock should not change in colour. If a colour seems to bleed, it is likely that it is residue, and subsequent washes will remove it.

It is recommended to wash hammocks by hand also to preserve the life of the hammock details, like the fringe or the end chords. If a hammock with a delicate fringe is repeatedly washed by machine, the threads will get tangled and begin to fray.
